BILL CREDITS: Strong financials lead to end-of-year return

The Mor-Gran-Sou Electric Cooperative board of directors and management staff have good news to share. Members, you will find a bill credit on your December billing statements.

Mor-Gran-Sou is a nonprofit business that exists only to provide goods and services to you, our member-owners; not to make a profit for a shareholder or investor. Cooperatives are operated to provide electric service to their members at the lowest cost possible. At the end of each year, Mor-Gran-Sou completes its financials and prepares a budget to plan for future needs.

As the board of directors and management staff plan for the future, they also reflect on the current financial strength of the co-op. During the October board meeting, Mor-Gran-Sou's directors noted the 2019 financials are stronger than forecasted, and at their discretion, saw an opportunity to initiate a bill credit to the membership, rather than retain it. Please look for your credit on the line item on your December electric statement entitled "MGS Bill Credit."

Safety tips for kids

Last month's newsletter published safety tips to reduce the risk of home fires and electrical safety hazards.

The answers are published in red.

- 1. Candles and matches should only be used by adults.
- 2. An adult should always stay in the kitchen when something is cooking.
- 3. Smoke alarms should be tested every **month** to ensure they are working. Batteries should be replaced at least once every **year** or right away if they start to "beep."
- 4. Make sure all **candles** are blown out before leaving a room.
- 5. Keep any items that can burn away from the stove, toaster and other cooking appliances.

Mor-Gran-Sou's 2020 annual meeting: July 17

It's time to consider serving as a board director for Mor-Gran-Sou. The initial commitment is a three-year term, with provisions in the bylaws limiting a director to serving six consecutive three-year terms, after which time the director is not eligible for another six consecutive three-year terms until one year has elapsed.

At the annual meeting, the following three board positions will be elected:

- The Grant County position presently held by Casey Wells;
- The Mandan-Area position presently held by Robert Leingang; and
- The Sioux County position presently held by Lance Froelich.

Under the bylaws and due to the use of a mail-in ballot, no nominations are accepted from the floor at the annual meeting. The bylaws require the board of directors to appoint a Nominating Committee of five to nine members who geographically represent the co-op. These members will provide a list of qualified and willing candidates to the board for approval and inclusion on the ballot at the board of directors' meeting scheduled for March 25, 2020. This date has been set so there is adequate time for each candidate's biographical information to be included with the notice of meeting sent to the members in June, along with the mail-in ballot for those who are unable to attend the annual meeting in person.

The Nominating Committee has been appointed by the board and will meet for the first time, set for Jan. 13, 2020. The members of the Nominating Committee include Bryce Allen, Mandan; Jennifer Bonogofsky, St. Anthony; Jackie Buckley, Mandan; Glenda Gross, Selfridge; Alan Malm, Flasher; Garek Murphy, Fort Yates; Rodney Nelson, Almont; Jim Neubauer, Mandan; and Shari Striegel, Carson.

For a person to be nominated, the member vying for a board seat must submit the completed declaration of candidacy form to Mor-Gran-Sou by 4 p.m. CT (3 p.m. MT) on Tuesday, March 10, 2020. The completed form must be mailed to Mor-Gran-Sou Electric Cooperative, Attn: Jackie Miller, P.O. Box 297, Flasher, ND, 58535-0297. If you or someone you know is interested in being nominated, please contact one of the Nominating Committee members or Jackie at Mor-Gran-Sou by calling 800-750-8212, 701-663-0297 or 701-597-3301. The Nominating Committee members or Jackie can provide you or the potential candidate with the declaration of candidacy form. If you have questions, give Jackie a call. All qualified and willing candidates who have completed and forwarded the written declaration of candidacy form to the Mor-Gran-Sou office by the March 10 deadline will be included in the list the Nominating Committee will provide to the board.

Bylaws and resolutions for the annual meeting

Under the bylaws, any bylaw amendments or resolutions must be presented to the members in writing in advance of the annual meeting scheduled for July 17. The board of directors has charged the Nominating Committee with reviewing and advising the board of any proposed bylaw amendments and resolutions. Therefore, any proposed bylaw amendments and resolutions should be submitted in writing no later than March 19, 2020, and/or they can be presented in-person at one of the following in-person meetings of the Nominating Committee:

- Jan. 13, in the Mor-Gran-Sou office board room in Flasher at 7 p.m. CT
- March 19, in the Mor-Gran-Sou office board room in Flasher at 7 p.m. CT
